Steel Tonnage 2,150 tonnes

Caunton designed, fabricated, delivered and erected 2,150 tonnes of steel for the office development in the City of London.

The building comprised of 22,000m² of lettable office space on 7 levels and offered magnificent views across the River Thames overlooking the Globe Theatre.

The steel frame is fire protected with intumescent paint which was applied both at the works and on site.

Caunton received the prestigious 1999 Steel Design Award for this project, which also won the BCO National Urban Workplace of the Year Award 1999.
