Hidden within the impressive façade of the former Pearl Assurance headquarters lays 850 tonnes of structural steelwork supplied and erected by Caunton Engineering Limited

With the exception of the front part of this listed building and an inner courtyard façade, which were both retained, the remainder of the building was demolished down to the existing third floor and in some cases down to the basement.

Following exposure of all remaining existing steelwork, Caunton set about the strengthening works and the new connections needed to carry the new floors above.

The existing steel was spliced and a further 4 new floors and 2 plant rooms were added.

In addition to the steelwork, Caunton also undertook the management for the supply and installation of the metal floor decking, erected from the basement upwards.
