Caunton Engineering were awarded the contract for the design, supply and erection of 2,500 tonnes of structural steelwork for a major distribution warehouse at what was one of the country's top distribution locations, the DIRFT freight terminal in Daventry. This massive building was pre-let to Tesco by major developer, the British Land / Rosemound Developments joint venture. The joint venture was developing their substantial 74 acre site at DIRFT.

The structural steelwork, a five span portal frame construction, encompassed over 75,000sq.ft of warehouse and included 35,000sq.ft of office. The clear height is 19.5 metres.

The main contractor for this development was John Sisk and Sons Ltd.
