The architects had likened the shape of this school's structure to an 'Ammonite'; Caunton's erectors identified it as a 'saw blade' – which reflected their own trade skills. Everyone involved agreed that the steel framed school building for Bewerley Primary School near Leeds was an exciting design.

Erection of the frame, by Caunton Engineering was completed in January 2006. The traditional closing ceremony for the steelwork erection phase – the tightening of the last two bolts – was most appropriately carried out by two future pupils of the school.

Contractor Kier completed the building the whole building by November with the school starting in earnest in the New Year of 2007.
