Caunton worked with Vinci Plc company, Norwest Holst, once again on a PFI Schools project. Following on from the great success by Norwest Holst (with Caunton as their steelwork supplier) on the Derby PFI schools contract, Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council announced Vinci Plc as its preferred partner for the £45 million Doncaster Schools PFI scheme. This provided two new secondary schools at Edlington and Mexborough.

Caunton enjoyed being part of their team to deliver this. Caunton fabricated, supplied and erected 800 tonnes of steelwork, working to engineer's Scott Wilson's design on the two schools. Both schools combined steel framed and concrete framed construction in the adjacent independent wings. Caunton provided initial cost engineering to Norwest and Scot Wilson to assist economic development of the scheme design.
