Caunton Engineering fabricated, supplied and erected 250 tonnes of main and secondary steelwork for the eight buildings at Donington Park, as the headquarters for Formula E, the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile's electric racing series.

The project consisted of six single span portal frame structures, which measured 42 metres by 15 metres. The buildings were divided in half with internal partitions which formed workshops for the Formula E teams. A further two similar sized steel structures were also built, one was divided into a workshop and offices for Formula E, whilst the other was used as an administrative headquarters by Donington Park Racing.

All the facilities met the BREEAM 'Very Good' rating.
